

**CITY COUNCIL MEETING
OZARK, ALABAMA
TUESDAY, OCTOBER 4, 2022**

The City Council of the City of Ozark, Alabama, met in Regular Session in the Council Chamber of the Municipal Complex at 5:30 P.M. on Tuesday, October 4, 2022. Upon roll call the following members were present:

Also present: Denise Strickland, who acted as clerk of the meeting, Chief Philip Prince, Chief Charles Ward, Deputy Chief Michael Bryan, Denise Ellis, Ryan Campbell, Joseph McNabb, Ozzie Maianeto, Justin Byrd and Joe Adams.

Councilmember Enfinger gave the prayer followed by Mayor Blankenship leading everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Council having read the minutes from the Regular Council Meeting held on September 20, 2022 President Pro Tem Jackson asked the wishes of the Council. Councilmember Enfinger made a motion to approve the minutes of the Regular Council Meeting held on September 20, 2022, which motion was seconded by Councilmember Perault. The Council voted unanimously in favor thereof.

Council President Pro Tem Jackson advised the Council that it was time to set the Agenda. Councilmember Harlow made a motion to set the Agenda as presented, which motion was seconded by Councilmember Enfinger. The Council voted unanimously in favor thereof.

Mayor Blankenship advised the Council that Friends of Army Aviation-Ozark would like to extend an existing thirty (30) year lease for property located at 189 Heritage Way for another ten (10) years. Councilmember Harlow made a motion to extend the lease agreement with Friends of Army Aviation-Ozark, which motion was seconded by Councilmember Perault. The Council voted unanimously in favor thereof.

Holle Smith said that Pray Aviation would like to enter into a lease agreement at the Ozark-Dale County Technology Center for Developing Industry for one (1) year at an annual rate of \$7,752.00 (\$646.00 per month). Councilmember Perault made a motion to approve the lease agreement with Pray Aviation, which motion was seconded by Councilmember Enfinger. The Council voted unanimously in favor thereof.

Holle Smith presented a list of candidates for membership on the Historic Preservation Commission; Angela Maultsby, Rachel Barefield, Laura Bruce, Leah Harlow, Ozzie Maianeto, Matthew Simechak, Holle Smith, Charles Veneziano and Rosmarie Williamson. Councilmember Perault made a motion to approve the list of candidates, which motion was seconded by Councilmember Enfinger. Ayes: Councilmember Jackson, Councilmember Perault and Councilmember Enfinger. Councilmember Harlow abstained from the vote. The motion passed.

Council President Pro Tem Jackson advised the Council that due to the Second Congressional District Municipal Meeting and Dinner, the November 1, 2022 City Council Meeting would need to be rescheduled. Councilmember Enfinger made a motion to reschedule the meeting for Monday, November 7, 2022, which motion was seconded by Councilmember Harlow. The Council voted unanimously in favor thereof.

With there being no further business to come before this Regular Council Meeting of October 4, 2022, Councilmember Enfinger made a motion to adjourn, which motion was seconded by Councilmember Perault. The Council voted unanimously in favor thereof.
