

**CITY COUNCIL MEETING
OZARK, ALABAMA
TUESDAY, JULY 18, 2023**

The City Council of the City of Ozark, Alabama, met in Regular Session in the Council Chamber of the Municipal Complex at 5:30 P.M. on Tuesday, July 18, 2023. Upon roll call the following members were present:

Councilmember Perault gave the prayer followed by Council Member Enfinger leading everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Council having read the minutes from the Regular Council Meeting held on July 11, 2023, President Pro Tem Jackson asked the wishes of the Council. Councilmember Enfinger made a motion to approve the minutes of the Regular Council Meeting held on July 11, 2023, which motion was seconded by Councilmember Harlow. The Council voted unanimously in favor thereof.

Council President Pro Tem Jackson advised the Council that it was time to set the Agenda. Councilmember Harlow made a motion to set the Agenda as presented, which motion was seconded by Councilmember Perault. The Council voted unanimously in favor thereof.
