Councilmember Perault gave the prayer followed by Mayor Blankenship leading everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Council having read the minutes from the Regular Council Meeting held on March 7, 2023 President Simechak asked the wishes of the Council. Councilmember Enfinger made a motion to approve the minutes of the Regular Council Meeting held on March 7, 2023, which motion was seconded by Councilmember Perault. The Council voted unanimously in favor thereof.

Council President Simechak advised the Council that it was time to set the Agenda. Councilmember Jackson made a motion to set the Agenda removing Item #8 and adding Item #12, a Resolution Declaring Certain Properties with Dangerous Buildings a Public Nuisance (215 Dogwood Circle), which motion was seconded by Councilmember Enfinger. Councilmember Jackson introduced a Resolution authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a Statutory Warranty Deed conveying property to JaTi's Investments LLC and moved for its adoption, which motion was seconded by Councilmember Harlow. The Council voted unanimously in favor thereof.

Councilmember Perault made a motion to grant the request to move Ozark Health and Fitness to Union Central in exchange for property located on the corner of Union and East Avenue, which motion was seconded by Councilmember Enfinger. The Council voted unanimously in favor thereof.

Councilmember Enfinger introduced a Resolution Declaring Certain Properties with Dangerous Buildings a Public Nuisance (215 Dogwood Circle) and moved for its adoption, which motion was seconded by Councilmember Harlow. The Council voted unanimously in favor thereof.
