The City Council of the City of Ozark, Alabama, met in Regular Session in the Council Chamber of the Municipal Complex at 5:30 P.M. on Tuesday **OCTOBER 21, 2025**. Upon roll call the following members were present:

Councilmember Enfinger gave the prayer followed by Council President Simechak leading everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Council having read the minutes from the Regular Council Meeting held on **OCTOBER 7, 2025** President Simechak asked the wishes of the Council. Councilmember Jackson made a motion to approve the minutes of the Regular Council Meeting held on **OCTOBER 7, 2025** which motion was seconded by Councilmember Perault. The Council voted unanimously in favor thereof.

Council President Simechak advised the Council that it was time to set the Agenda. Councilmember Perault made a motion to set the Agenda with the addition of Item #8, a request to increase the City's ACH Limit with Commercial Bank for payroll purposes, which motion was seconded by Councilmember Enfinger. The Council voted unanimously in favor thereof.

Councilmember Harlow introduced an ordinance to rezone 1302 Willow Oaks Dr from R-1 to RH and moved for its adoption which motion was seconded by Councilmember Perault. The Council voted unanimously in favor thereof.

Councilmember Enfinger introduced an ordinance to rezone 473 and 493 Parker Drive from I-1 to RH and moved for its adoption which motion was seconded by Councilmember Harlow. The Council voted unanimously in favor thereof.

Councilmember Jackson made a motion to set the Organizational Meeting for November 3, 2025 at 11 am which motion was seconded by Councilmember Perault. The Council voted unanimously in favor thereof.

Councilmember Perault made a motion to authorize CFO/City Clerk to execute an ACH agreement with Commercial Bank to increase the limit to \$250,000.00 for payroll purposes which motion was seconded by Councilmember Jackson. The Council voted unanimously in favor thereof.

With there being no further business to come before this Regular Council Meeting of **OCTOBER 21, 2025** Councilmember Enfinger made a motion to adjourn, which motion was seconded by Councilmember Harlow. The Council voted unanimously in favor thereof.
