The City Council of the City of Ozark, Alabama, met in Special Session in the Council Chamber of the Municipal Complex at 12:00 P.M. on September 2, 2025. Upon roll call the following members were present:

Councilmember Perault gave the prayer and Council President Simechak led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

President Simechak advised the Council it was time to set the Agenda. Councilmember Perault made a motion to set the Agenda as presented, which motion was seconded by Councilmember Jackson.

Councilmember Perault made a motion to approve the Certificate of Election for Caitlyn Cummings as Councilmember Place 5, which motion was seconded by Councilmember Jackson. The Council voted unanimously in favor thereof.
